Scouts need a team effort to assist them linking to Venturers

Scout Leaders

- Encourage 14 year old Scouts to explore their options;
- Find out and have information available for Scouts about Venturer Units in the District;
- Be aware of the membership and linking requirements of the Venturer section;
- Encourage your Scouts to participate in the Try Venturing badge - Scout Leaders also welcome!
- Be aware of Branch and National events for the Venturer section;
- Introduce the Venturer Leader to the Scout parents.

Parents of Scouts

- The Scout section is one of five youth sections in Scouting;
- Scouts are typically aged 10.5 to 14.5 years, with the flexibility of +/- six months;
- Is your child aware of the next section? Venturers!
- Venturers are typically aged 14.5 to 17.5 years, with the flexibility of +/- six months;
- Ask your child's Scout Leader to introduce you to the Venturer Leader;
- Find out where and when they meet;
- Ask about other Units nearby.

Venturer Leaders

- The Unit should have regular contact and activities with Scout Troops in the District;
- Promote the Try Venturing badge and linking activities;
- Recognise and respect Scout section training:
 - Scout program,
 - Australian Scout Medallion;
 - Adventurer Cord;
- Practise and promote RPL
 - Recognition of Prior Learning;
- Publish and promote the:
 - Venturer Unit Program;
 - The value of venturing;
 - Branch and National events;
- Participate in the development of Venturer program items at combined section events.
